

There are 4 types of sentences.

- Declarative
- Interrogative
- Imperative
- Exclamatory

Each kind of sentence ends with its own special punctuation mark.




Let's look at each of these sentences.



Type of Sentence	Use	Punctuation Mark
Declarative	Makes a statement	Period (.)
Interrogative	Asks a question	Question Mark (?)
Imperative	Gives a command or makes a request	Period (.)
Exclamatory	Expresses strong feeling	Exclamation Mark (!)

Here are some examples.



Declarative	Sharon and Paul found a lost puppy . We get lots of snow in the winter .	
Interrogative	May I borrow your pencil sharpener ? What time do you get up in the morning ?	
Imperative	Pick up the book . Clean your room .	
Exclamatory	It's a beautiful day! I won a million dollars!
